Declaration of Integrity and Transparency

Administration of the Science and Technology Research Institute, Chiang Mai University

In accordance with the government's policies for promotion of good governance and prevention of corruption and misconduct in the government sector organization as well as its strategic plan on good governance Phase 3 (2017-2021), which mandates the development of good work ethics among government officials and public servants, as well as improving the administrative transparency of the agency overall, and stop corruption among government officials and public servants, so that the administration of the government may be trusted by the people.

In the budget year of 2017, the Office of the Higher Education Commission (OHEC) received the mandate from the Office of the National Anti-Corruption Commission (ONACC) to take responsibility of conducting evaluations of government agencies, in particular, public higher education institutions, as well as those under the authority of the government. The evaluation aims to measure and determine the integrity and transparency of an agency. As a higher education institution, Chiang Mai University will be evaluated by the Integrity and Transparency Assessment (ITA).

On 21th February 2017, Chiang Mai University implemented a set of policies in order to develop the administration of the university in 6 policies based on the government's policies on increasing transparency and improving integrity; using it as a ethical standard and guideline. In addition, incorporating these as core values that should be upheld by all Chiang Mai University staff, on top of the other rules and regulations. The above mentioned 6 policies include :

1. Transparency
2. Accountability
3. Corruption - free work behaviors in the workplace
4. Organization ethical culture
5. Work ethics
6. Communication in the workplace

As an organization within Chiang Mai University, the Science and Technology Research Institute thereby announces to uphold the Declaration of Integrity and Transparency, in accordance with the university's administrative policies, to develop the agency's integrity and transparency, based on good governance. In addition, encourage and support staff to see and reflect on the importance of good work ethics, on top of improving administrative performances, which will be to the betterment of the organization.
